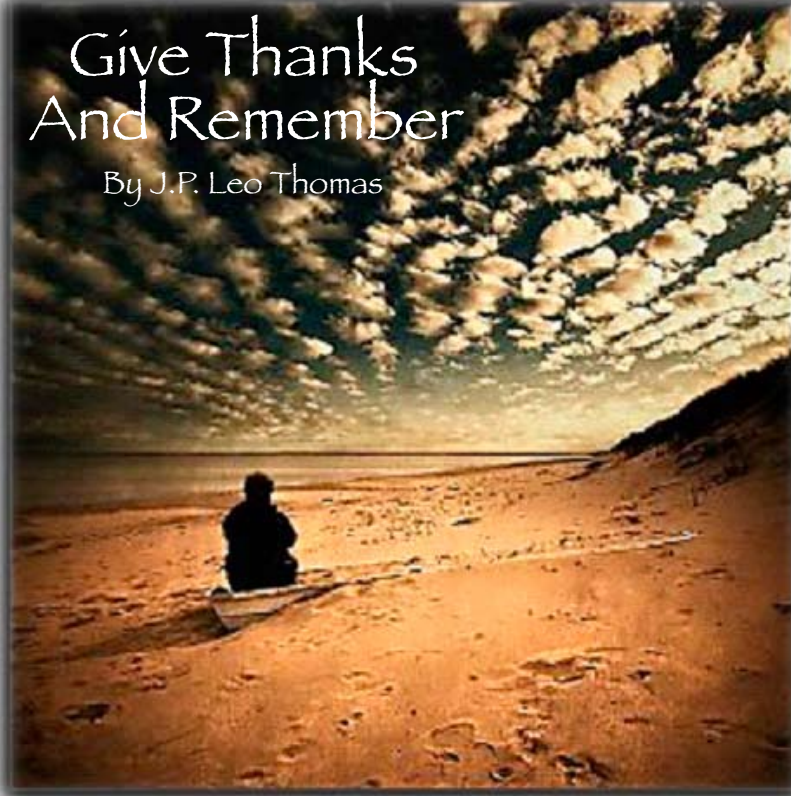
We will have a first degree on 10/12 at 7 pm before our business meeting at 8am. please come to the both meetings.
